

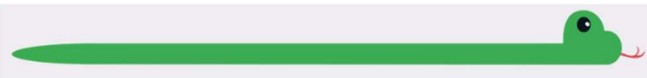
## This Week.....

In PE we have been practicing lots of different skills. This week we focused on stopping safely and playing games like Friendship Train and Firefighters

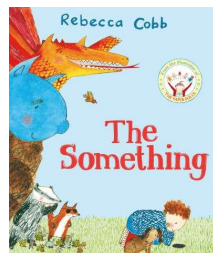
