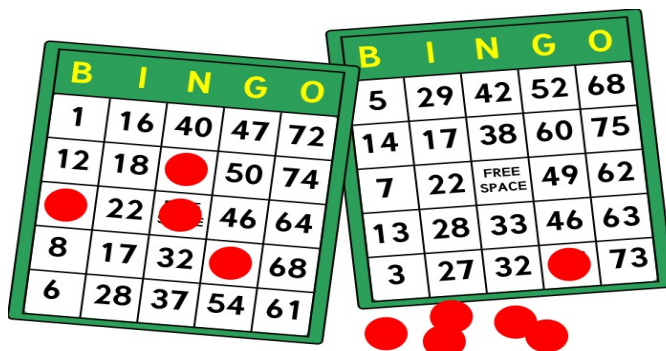


Anti-Bullying Week
