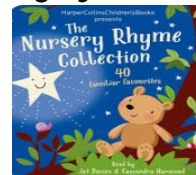

### Home Reading Books



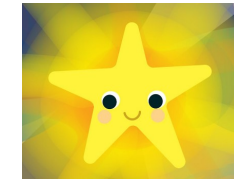
