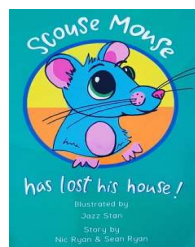
In maths we have been learning all about circles and triangles and we have been identifying these and comparing them. See if your child can find any triangles or circles at home?
