
## This Week.....

We have continued learning our letters and sounds. In phonics we learnt the digraphs 'sh, th, ng, nk'. A digraph is two letters together that make one sound. We have read words like rush, moth, ring and sink. This week we learnt 3 new tricky words, he, she and of.

In maths we have been learning all about the number 4. We have been counting forwards and backwards and recognising 4 in lots of different ways eg: dice pattern, numicon shape, number blocks character, 4 on a five and ten frame and 4p.
