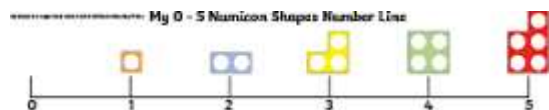


This Week.....

A digraph is two letters that make one sound and a trigraph is three letters that make one sound. In phonics we learnt the sounds 'ai' 'ee' 'igh' and 'oa'. We also practised all of our tricky words from last term.

In maths we have been ordering numbers to 5 and finding the missing numbers in a number track.



We had so much fun exploring the snow this week, brrrrr it was cold! We continued with our winter theme in our continuous provision. We made measured capacity using snowballs. We added beads to the snowflakes at the funky fingers area.
