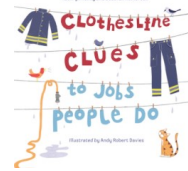

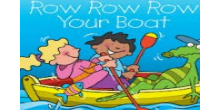
This week the children have enjoyed celebrating World Book Day. If your child has a favourite story book then share this at home, or join the local library and see what lovely stories they have to take home and share.
