We had lots of fun in PE on Monday. We have been enjoying playing stopping and starting games such as the traffic light game. We also focussed on finding a space and moving in different ways.

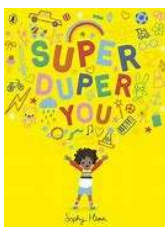

These children have been caught going over and above this week!

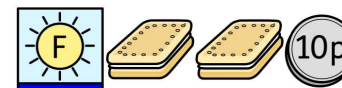
Biscuit Day
