In maths, we have been learning about matching and sorting into sets. The children have been busy sorting object by colour, size, feature and matching sets that are the same.






This week the children enjoyed learning all about the Jewish festival Rosh Hashanah. We dipped apple into honey to celebrate a sweet New Year, it was delicious!






