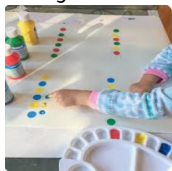
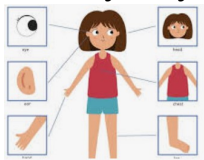

Parent's Evening



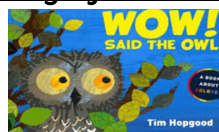

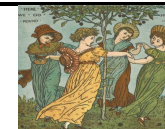
