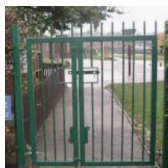
This week the children have also been reinforcing their knowledge of colours and were able to sort different coloured items. The children were brilliant at naming the items and their colours.

Reminder of Nursery Gate Opening Times



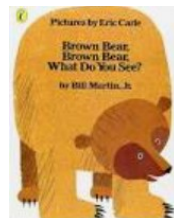
