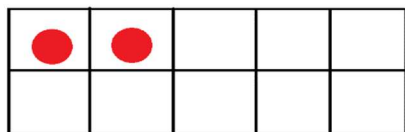


This Week....

In maths we have been learning all about the number 2 we have been finding what we have 2 of on our bodies e.g. we have 2 eyes, two arms 2 feet. We have also been recognising 2 in different ways like dice patterns, numicon shapes and showing it on a tens frame.

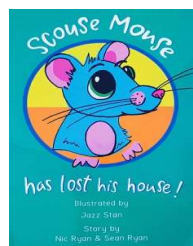
