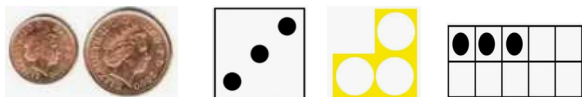


This Week.....

In maths we have been learning all about number three. We have located it on a number line and we know the number that is one more than and one less than. The children have been exploring lots of different ways to represent three including using money!



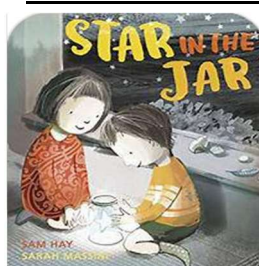
In art we have been exploring warm and cold colours and have created paintings inspired by the local artist Paul Curtis.
