Not a great week with only 1 class in green but well done to Tulips for great attendance! Let's see if we can improve next week before we finish for the holidays!

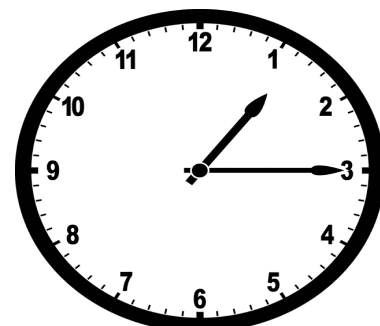
