The children have also been busy making lovely Mother's Day cards and they practise writing their names in their cards too.



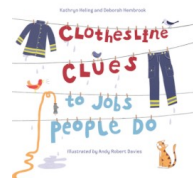
This week we also celebrated Red Nose Day and Nursery decorated their own fantastic red nose biscuits.
