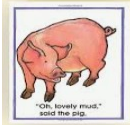


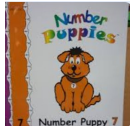

Sun Hats, Sunglasses and Sun Cream

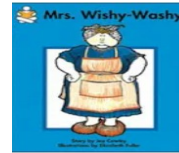

Home Learning Challenge

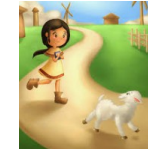


This week the children have been able to identify two during their number work. Ask your child to find two of each toy, for example, find two teddies and find two dolls.
