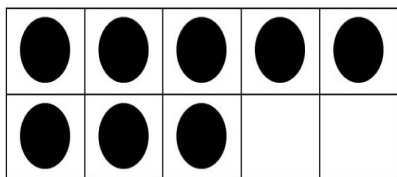
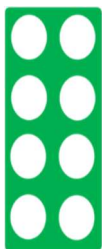


This Week.....

Welcome back, we hope you all have had a lovely Easter break.

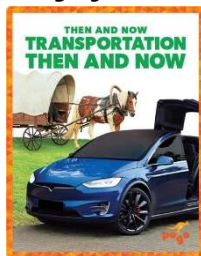
