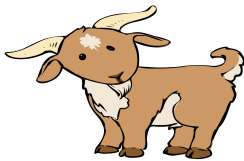

Deaf Awareness Week

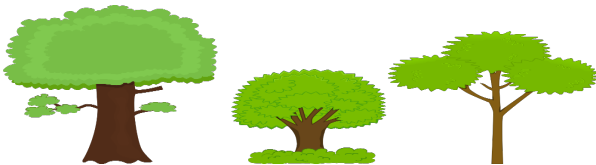
