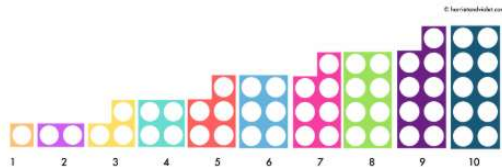


This Week....
