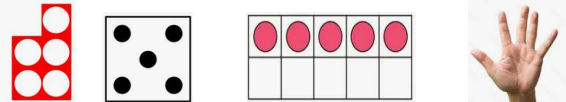


## This Week....

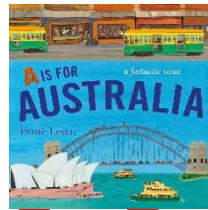


The children have been introduced to the Rekenreks in mastering number this week which they have loved using!
