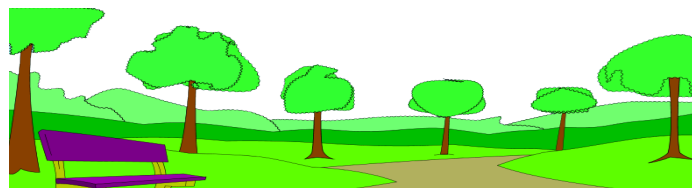
Sun Safety
