In maths we have been looking at the composition of 6. The children have used what they know about 6 to solve a problem.

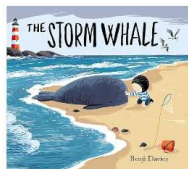
We have been learning all about what plants need to grow. We have enjoyed planting some seeds and are looking forward to watching these grow over the next few weeks.
