

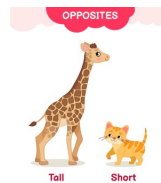

Home Learning Challenge



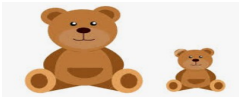
This week the children have been learning about tall and short. Ask your child to compare their toys and find out which are tall and which are short.

Nursery will close at 1.15pm on Friday 17th July.

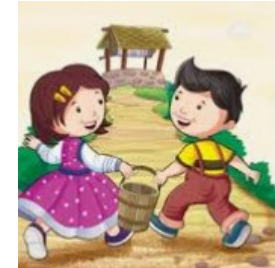
Children who attend Nursery in the afternoon will finish on Thursday 16th July.
