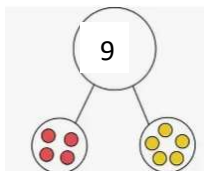


This Week...

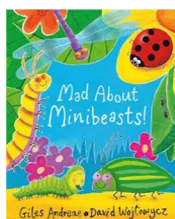
