Attendance Matters!

Attendance:

Attendance is MANDATORY for all pupils unless they are unwell. If your child / any member of your household develops Covid symptoms or has been advised to isolate, you should contact the school office for advice. If your child is absent from school without authorisation parents will be fined by the Local Authority.

Attendance and punctuality is very important at Lister. Improving school attendance is a key priority for the Council and its family of schools. The support of our parents is crucial to achieving our goal. The Government expects pupils to have a minimum level of attendance of at least 97%. We at Lister will be working towards this target for the forthcoming academic year.

All appointments should be arranged outside of the school day. If your child has an urgent medical appointment which cannot be rearranged, you will need to provide medical evidence before that absence will be authorised. This can be in the form of an appointment card, a letter from a GP, dentist, walk in centre, or hospital, or medication issued from that appointment, etc.
